## 3 Start your Learning Record

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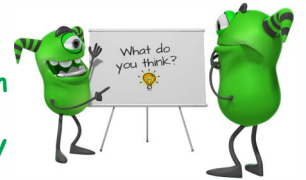
- \*Grab the Mathematics 2024 Challenge Learning Record and have a read
